

2018 South Florida Van Information

CHECK YOUR TRANSPORTATION ON THE CAMPER DASHBOARD OR YOUR LATEST INVOICE FOR YOUR STOP

CAMPERS MUST BE REGISTERED FOR VAN TRANSPORTATION (SEATING IS LIMITED)

New in 2018! The van will stop for a bathroom break ONLY

- Campers will be fed at Camp Horizon on arrival Sunday (estimated arrival 12:30pm).
- Campers will be provided a sack lunch during the trip home on Saturday (estimated departure 8:45am).

[] **Blvd:** The Pembroke Pines stop is at Boulevard Bible Chapel, 6800 Pines Boulevard.
Pembroke Pines Sunday departure time is 7:30 AM on Sunday
Pembroke Pines Saturday arrival time is 1:30 - 2:00 PM on Saturday

[] **PGA:** The PGA stop is in the LA Fitness parking lot just off the Turnpike PGA Boulevard exit.
PGA Sunday departure time is 8:30 – 9:00 AM on Sunday
PGA Saturday arrival time is 12:30 – 1:00 PM on Saturday

These arrival and departure times may vary due to unforeseen circumstances, **but the van can wait only ten minutes before proceeding to the next stop.** These times cannot be guaranteed but every effort will be made by the drivers to inform Camp Horizon (352-728-5822) when there are delays (according to direction of travel) and either a camp staff or a van transportation staff member will try to call a parent cell phone (the number on file on the camper record).

Van transportation for South Florida campers needing a ride to and from summer camp is coordinated for each scheduled week of camp through the camp registration system. The drivers are volunteers and screened the same as our on-site staff (level 2 w/fingerprinting).

LEGAL AGREEMENT

By placing your child on the South Florida Van you and your child agree that the rider will adhere to the Camp Horizon Standards of Conduct. Failure to obey the driver and/or chaperones may result in not being allowed on future trips.

By placing your child on the South Florida Van you and your child hold harmless Camp Horizon, it's staff and volunteers. You further agree that any claim or dispute shall be settled by mediation and, if necessary, legally binding arbitration in accordance with the Rules of Procedure for Christian Conciliation (see HisPeace.org).

The registration fee for the South Florida Van is non-refundable. Your camper's transportation fee covers only a portion of the actual cost. The rest of the cost is subsidized through the generosity of summer camp donors.

BEST PRACTICE

1. Young Campers: Place all money, correspondence, and medicines in a sealed bag (zip loc bags work well). Label it and give this to the driver. If it is packed – their check-in may be delayed while the look for their money and meds.
2. Any camper mail that you want delivered during the week should be in a labeled bag and given to the driver.
3. There is no meal stop! They are only stopping for a bathroom break.
Camp Horizon will provide a snack/drink for the ride home. You may provide a light snack for the trip to camp if desired.
4. Do not send your child to camp with a fever. If your child is sick – call the camp office.

If you need to contact the driver please call the camp office (352) 728-5822.

We will be able to text the van staff and have them call you back. The drivers are asked not to text/talk and drive.
